In Memoriam Bill Harrell Founder of Harrell & Harrell

Northeast Florida legal community icon William "Bill" H. Harrell, Jr., 70, died at his home on Saturday, Oct. 14 surrounded by family

following a lengthy battle with cancer. Harrell is best known for founding and leading Harrell & Harrell, P.A. – a personal injury law firm with 18 lawyers and 100 employees that has served the First Coast for more than 25 years.

Harrell was born Oct. 18, 1946 in Lake City, Florida. As the son of a career Air Force pilot, he grew up in places around the world.

Harrell followed his father's footsteps attending the University of Florida on a full athletic scholarship in football. After experiencing a career-ending knee injury as a freshman, Harrell followed another family tradition and enlisted in the U.S. Army as an infantryman. He was later appointed to the

After military service, Harrell attended the University of Florida, where he earned his law degree. In 1991, Harrell and his family moved to Jacksonville and started Harrell & Harrell, P.A., a widely-known, successful law firm specializing in personal injury. He practiced law at Harrell & Harrell with two of his four children and wife of nearly 20 years, Renee Daigle Harrell.

Harrell is survived by his wife Renee, four children, five grandchildren, and his sister, Judge Susan Harrell Black. A celebration of Harrell's life will be held at a later time. In lieu of flowers, the family requests that memorial donations be made to either the Shriner's Hospital for Children or the American Cancer Society.



In Memoriam Judge David B. Beck, 1947 - 2017

The Seventh Judicial Circuit sadly announces the passing of the Honorable David B. Beck, who served for 11 years as a Judge. He died

Saturday, Sept. 2 at the age of 69.

Born in Sharon, Penn., he grew up in the Ormond Beach area and graduated from Seabreeze High School, Daytona Beach.

He received both his bachelor and law degrees from the University of Florida. He also served in the U.S. Army, earning the rank of first lieutenant. After admission to the Florida Bar in 1975, he worked as an Assistant State Attorney in the 4th and 15th Circuits then as a corporate attorney in California, before returning to Volusia County in 1989. He worked as an Assistant State Attorney in the 7th Circuit and worked in private practice, becoming a certified mediator. In 2003, he was appointed as Volusia County Court Judge and was later appointed as Circuit Judge in 2011. He helped establish the first Veterans Court in the 7th Circuit in 2013 and served as its first judge. In May, the court was renamed in his honor.

He retired in 2014 and continued to serve as a senior judge. In addition to his work in the courtroom, Judge Beck was active in veterans groups and community organizations, including the Special Olympics. He is survived by his wife Carolyn, six children and ten grandchildren.
