Practice Tips

Administrative Orders

When modifying child support established as an Administrative Order the proper pleading is a “Petition for Superseding Child Support Order,” not a “Supplemental Petition to Modify.”

In the Final Judgment a paragraph stating that the Administrative Order is superseded by this action.

Note: Administrative Orders should be automatically reviewed every three years without proving a change in circumstances. Either party may request the review if it is not done automatically by DOR.

Marital Settlement Agreements

Suggested language if one party is ordered to pay alimony: “The Tax Cut and Jobs Act of 2017 does not apply to any modifications of this agreement or an order accepting it including any future agreements or orders modifying the alimony provisions set forth herein.”

The National Defense Authorization Act 2017 now requires additional language in marital settlement agreements: “On the date of the decree of divorce, dissolution, annulment of legal separation, (enter date here) the member’s military retired pay base (High 3) was (enter #) and the member had (enter number) years and (enter number) months of creditable service.

Statute Update regarding Mental Healthcare For Child(ren) FL statute 61.13(2)(b)3.a

a. Any and all forms of health care. If the court orders shared parental responsibility over health care decisions, *the parenting plan must provide that either parent may consent to mental health treatment for the child.*
