Did You Miss The July Program?

If you missed the July 10 program on the Tax Cuts and Jobs Act, here are some highlights from the presentation.

1. Most provisions of the Act will expire in 2025.
2. If you are married you may only file as “married filed jointly” or “married filing single/separate,” you cannot file as Head of Household.
3. To file as Head of Household you must list the child and social security number.
4. It is advisable to have a IRS Form 8332 submitted each year the nonmajority timesharing parent claims any child.
5. If your client currently pays alimony, your client should file an IRS form 10-99 with the IRS and provide to the former spouse.

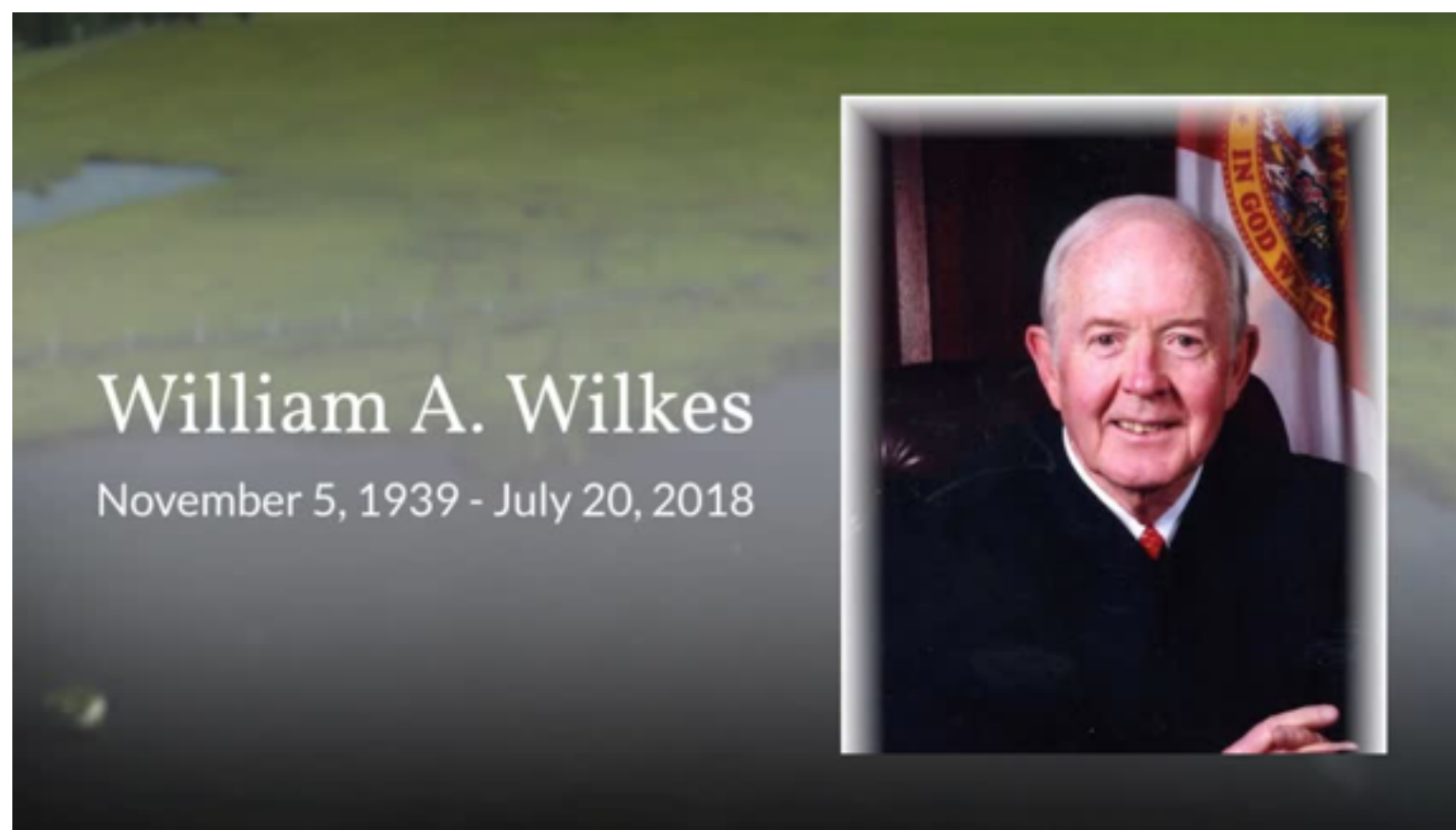

In Memory: Judge William A. Wilkes

It is with great sadness that we mark the passing of retired Circuit Judge William A. Wilkes.

Judge Wilkes passed away on July 20 at the age of 78. He is remembered for presiding over some of the toughest cases in the Fourth Judicial Circuit, including a quadruple murder death penalty trial that took place over a four-year period. Widely admired by judges and attorneys alike, Judge Wilkes was the longest serving judge in Clay County, from 1980 until he retired in 2010. He continued to preside over cases with senior status until recently. Judge Wilkes was a founding member and past president of the Clay County Bar Association and was a leader in the effort to build the Clay County Courthouse in Green Cove Springs. He is survived by his wife Delores.

Keys 2 Drive Program

The State Attorney's Office in coordination with the courts, Duval County Clerk of Courts, and law enforcement launched the KEYS 2 Drive program to help certain traffic offenders obtain a valid driver's license.
